General Guidelines for Recitals

Reservations for a specific recital are taken only via the student form found on the website which can be emailed to the recital chair.

Cancellation is made only in the event of illness.

The recital chairperson must be contacted no later than **two weeks** before the recital.

Final program order is left to the discretion of the recital chairperson.

The recital chairperson should keep the program to one hour playing time.

Please have pieces accurately timed before submitting them.

Program is filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Students may perform the same work a maximum of two times. A reasonable period of time should elapse between performances of the same piece.

Teachers may present students equaling 10 minutes of music per recital. In the event the recital is not full, time permitting, additional students may be added at the discretion of the recital chairperson. Students will be included in the order submitted.

If you have any questions about the recital or guidelines, please contact the recital chairperson.

DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire is required for all stage performances. Please refrain from wearing jeans, tee shirts, sports gear, flip-flops, sneakers, clogs, or platform shoes.; Dresses should be no shorter than knee-length.

Please dispose of your gum before performing.

Memorization is preferred at the discretion of the teacher.

Students must provide their own accompanist.
