GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR COMPETITIONS

Piano Competitions: Teachers must be members of CNYAMT by Oct. 1, 2011

Senior Level: Students must be not less than 15 years old as of March 1, and attending high school. Memorization is required.

Intermediate Level: Students must be not less than 13 years old and not more than 14 as of March 1. Memorization is required.

Junior Level: Students must be not less than 10 years old and not more than 12 as of March 1. Memorization is required.

Elementary Level: Students must be not less than 8 years old and not more than 9 as of March 1. Memorization is required.

Scholarship Competition: Students must be graduating seniors and planning to continue music instruction. This competition is open to vocal, instrumental, piano and organ students. Memorization is required for entrants. Teacher must be a member of CNYAMT for three consecutive years, and must be a current paid member. Teacher signature is required on application form.

Vocal Competition: Teachers must be members of CNYAMT by Oct. 1, 2012

Students must be in grades 9, 10, 11, or 12. Memorization is required.

Instrumental Competition: Teacher must be a member of CNYAMT by Oct. 1, 2011

Memorization is strongly recommended, but not required.

There will be three divisions, as listed below, depending on enrollment:

Junior Level: 8-11 years of age on competition date.

Intermediate Level: 12-14 years of age on competition date

Senior Level: 15-18 years of age and attending High School on competition date.

1. Competitions application forms are available on the website. Teachers may make copies as needed.
 2. It is the responsibility of the teacher of the student entering a competition to see that the completed application is made by the entry deadline. Late applicants will be considered if enrollment allows. A late fee will be assessed.
 3. The Guidelines for Competitions will be available on the website or mailed to teachers upon request. Call or email Competition Co-Chairs. Each teacher participating in these competitions is obliged to cooperate with the Code of Ethics of this organization and within the Guidelines.
